IMPROVING SPEAKING SKILL BY USING PODCAST AT THE ELEVENTH GRADE OF SMA NEGERI 5 PEMATANG SIANTAR

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ABSTRACT

The aim of this research was to to analyze the effect of Using Podcast media on students's speaking skill at the eleventh th grade of SMA Negeri 5 Pematangsiantar. in the academic year 2022/2023. This research located in medan street, Kec.Siantar Martoba, Pematangsiantar. This research used quantitative approach with true experimental design. The population in this research is the eleventh grade students at SMA Negeri 5 Pematangsiantar with total sample is 32. The data were obtained by using pretest and posttest. The data of the pretest and post- test of both groups were analyzed by using descriptive and inferential statistics (SPSS 26.0). The result of the research shows that the testing hypothesis of posttest scores was found that tcount = $18.296 > t_{table} = 1.699$ at the significance level a = 0.05 and degrees of freedom (df) = 29. So, H0 is rejected and Ha is accepted. It means that the Using of Podcast media effect significantly on student speaking skill at SMA Negeri 5 Pematangsiantar in academic year 2022/2023.

II. REVIEW OF LITERATURE

Description of Speaking

Speaking is a productive skill similar to writing. It has its own genre because it has several stages to achieve the goal of using language interactively (Martin & Rose, 2012). Speaking involves sound to express the meaning you want to make interaction occurs. That is, speaking is an interactive communication process that connects ideas between the speaker and the interlocutor with a specific purpose. Speaking is a process of sharing and building a sense of using spoken/verbal in various contexts. Speaking is the act of making vowel sounds, helping to persuade listeners to follow a message, in a convincing and tactful manner. (Harmer, 2002) mentions speaking is about producing words in the right order. Speaking does not only involve vocal sounds but also needs to be aware of aspects of speaking which include the general structure of speaking events that need to be followed sequentially or are called genres (Samad & Adnan, 2017).

Description of Media

Media is a means to transfer or deliver messages. Li-Ling Kuo states that a medium is called educational media when the media conveys messages for teaching (Li-Ling, 1996). He added that the use of media is important and it is impossible to coordinate teaching with learning without using media (Li-Ling, 1996). Media is flexible because it can be used for all levels of students and in all subjects.

Teaching media can also encourage students to take more responsibility and control over their own learning, engage in syllabus planning together, and take a long-term perspective on their own learning (Masterman, 1999). Because the media provides many advantages, a teacher must consider the media to be used in the teaching and learning process.

According to (Sloan, 2005), podcasting is an innovative way of broadcasting through the Internet and can be used for transferring digital audio content automatically to mobilephones. (Gromik, 2008) claims that podcasting can provide learners with "access to resources which are authentic, free and otherwise not available" in non-English speaking contexts. Scholars have offered some reasons for including podcasts in language learning classrooms.

Podcasting is possible anytime and anywhere. Students can save their time, money and energy by downloading and listening to the podcasts at their convenience.

Personalization is an option that podcasting can provide for learner stomatch their learning style sand strategies. (Mc Rae, 2010) defines personalized learning as assessing and addressing individual learners' strengths based on their specific need and learning styles.

III. RESEARCH METHODOLOGY

The Research Design

This research was conducted using an experimental method with one group, namely the experimental class. This is intended to test and prove the hypothesis by giving treatment to the sample. One group pre test – post test is a research design in which one group of participants is pre tested on the dependent variable and then given a post tested after the treatment condition has been assigned. This shows whether the Podcast as a medium has an effect on speaking skills.

The Location of Research

This research was conducted at SMA NEGERI 5 Pematang Siantar. This location was chosen because students at the school have difficulty speaking, especially in introducing themselves. Podcasts as media are expected to help students in speaking

The Population and Sample

The population for this study was taken from eleventh grade students of SMA 5 Pematang Siantar for the 2022/2023 academic year. There are ten parallel classes. XI IPS there are five class. The number of students in each class is 32 students. So the total population is 160 students samples were taken from class XI- IPS 4, the reason for choosing this class in this study was because in carrying out teaching assistance previously, students in this class had difficulty speaking. The data of the study was collected by asking the students to write self-introduction present it in front of the class orally. It was given to the students in order to know theirpronunciation, fluency, accuracy and vocabulary in English. The test was given to studentsthataimstocollect the data insupporting the students mastery in speaking.

The Technique of Collection Data

Incollecting the data, there searcher compiled the scores from the steps below:

- 1. The test was given to experiment group. In the first meeting was to collect the pre-tests cores, and the test was a written and oral test.
- 2. In the last meeting was by using Podcastas media inexperimental group. There searcher made the same test again to this class to collect the post test scores, and the testwas awritten and oral test. Listing the score of pre –test and post- test in to the table for the experimental group.

The Technique of Analyzing Data

Technique of analyzing data in this research uses mean formula to know the average of students' score and to check students' self confident improvement in speaking. In scoring the pre-test and the post - test, the researcher adopted oral proficiency scoring categories developed by Brown in (Arikunto, 2010) it is stated that there are five important items need to be scored such as grammar, vocabulary, comprehension, fluency, and pronunciation. After knowing the score of the students will give the level achievement to the students. The researcher calculating the frequency and normality of the test by using SPSS version 26.0.

IV. THE DATA AND DATA ANALYSIS

The Data and Data Analysis

This chapter discusses about the data that the researcher during the research. The researcher analyzed the data to find out the effects significantly of using Podcast media in speaking skill at

The Research Finding and Discussion

The purpose of this research is to find out the differences in students learning outcomes and to find out the effect of using Podcast media on speaking skill at eleventh grade of SMA Negeri 5 pematang Siantar.

The findings in pretest of experimental class the total of score is 2104, the data is valid 100% with total students are 32 the mean of the posttest in experimental class is 76.44 and standard deviation 3.902.Median of posttest experimental class is 75.50 with variance 15.222 and range 14. The maximum score is 84 and the minimum score is 70. The total of post-test score is 2376. To find out the data is normal or not, we call be seen in the normality table as below.

Meanwhile The Research finding significance a = 0.05. The data is said to be distributed normal if sig > 0.05 and then data is said to be not distributed normal if sig < 0.05. Based on the table above, it is found that the sample of the research is 32 with mean = 76.44 and standard deviation = 3.902. The score of absolute = 144, score positive 144, and negative score = -093, Statistic test is 144, and significant value is 0.02, so sig > 0.05 (0.2 > 0.05). It means that post-test score in control class is distributed normal.

V. CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

Conclusion

Significant differences in speaking skills between those taught podcast and those who are not eleventh graders of SMA Negeri 5 Pematang Siantar. T count compared to t_{table} is good at the 0.05 level statistic 0.05 t_{table} is 1.680. Based on t table, it can be analyzed that t count is higher than t table, at the 0.05 level, in other words we can read 4,437 > 1,680. Thus, the researcher concluded that H02 was rejected an Ha2 is accepted meaning there is a significant difference in usage podcast for class eleventh at SMA Negeri 5 Pematang Siantar.
